DENOUNCES FOR VIOLATIONS OF THE RIGHTS SET OUT IN THE CONVENTION AGAINST TORTURE AND OTHER CRUEL, INHUMAN OR DEGRADING TREATMENT OR PUNISHMENT OF THE AMAZONAS (MANAUS) GOVERNMENT

in the face of the **Governor of the State of Amazonas, Mr. Wilson Miranda Lima**, requesting an investigation and punishment by the UN international committee

1. FACTS

The dire situation experienced by the state of Amazonas is not an isolated act of abnormality, but the result of a multifactorial sequence of management errors by the local executive branch. The decision-makers, led by the Governor and Deputy Governor of the State of Amazonas, since the beginning of the current pandemic crisis, have acted with total contempt for the population, transforming an already worrying situation into a true humanitarian disaster.

It is noteworthy, already in a preamble note, that the cases of corruption in the situation arising from COVID-19 in Rio de Janeiro and Manaus are umbilically interconnected, from the complex web of participants (varied individuals and legal entities, with the use of numerous “Oranges” and strategic appointments), up to the common objective aimed at diverting federal public resources.

If that were not enough, more recently, the situation has proved even more serious. The result of the reckless management on the part of the above accused culminated in a true state of barbarism in the state of Amazonas. Patients admitted for treatment of Covid-19



cannot count on oxygen supply, as there is NO MORE reserve of cylinders in the state! Today, in the state, there is a deficit of 48,300 cubic meters of oxygen. There are many moving reports on social networks that report patients who, in the absence of respirators, are subjected to manual ventilation to prevent death from suffocation - which, unfortunately, is sometimes unavoidable. In this real war scenario, the company White Martins, one of the main oxygen suppliers for health centers in Manaus, said it had communicated to the State Government, a few days earlier, about the possibility of a lack of medicinal oxygen.

What did the Governor do in the face of this situation?

The crisis was predicted and should have been prevented or, at least, mitigated by the Governor. In his position as public manager, he had the legal obligation to provide in advance the logistics necessary for the production and / or import of mechanical respirators. After nine months of the pandemic, has the government been unable to predict the basic items of care and maintenance of patients' lives in hospitals and stock them on a large scale? This lack of organization can only be attributed to a lack of organization, prudence, probity and morality.

Today, January 20, 2021, the Amazon is experiencing the most terrible day in its history. Doctors cry in hospitals because they are forced to decide who should be saved and who should die. A real scenario of war, accompanied in cold blood by a government that was not able to manage the crisis, thus incurring a crime of responsibility.

In addition to the crime of responsibility, the Governor of Amazonas visibly committed crimes against humanity related to psychological torture, including health workers who have been unpaid for two months and even more the sick who die every day in hospitals (average of 200 deaths per day)
